DID YOU KNOW?

A very key theme in Luke's writings is that of journey. In the Gospel, Jesus' journey to Jerusalem is the vehicle for his preaching and formation of the disciples in what it means to be a follower of Christ.

Luke's second volume is The Acts of the Apostles. In this book, the message of Jesus is taken by the Church outward from Jerusalem to the ends of the Earth.

There existed an ancient rivalry between the Samaritans and the Jews, which caused each group to be suspicious of the other. The area of Samaria lay between Galilee in the north and Judea in the south.
